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Welcome to our programs and services

Our Free Programs

Parents & Professionals can refer to programs

Infant Development Program (IDP)

ages 0 to 3 yrs. old

We support families and children who may have a developmental delay or have a diagnosis.

Supported Child Development (SCD)

ages 0 to school age

We support children who need extra support to take part in their preschool, daycare or after school programs.

Occupational Therapy & Physiotherapy (OT, PT)

ages 0 to school age

We support parents with concerns about the development of their children.

Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD)

Key Worker, ages 0 to 18 yrs. old

We help families & other professionals understand FASD, keeping the needs of the child or youth first in mind. We can also help get an assessment of FASD and other complex behaviour disorders.

For Fee Services

*Families can use ASD Funding or pay privately
An Autism diagnosis is not required.*

The Nest

for children under 6 yrs. old

Individualized to your child's needs based on your family priorities and the Behaviour Consultants assessment.

Positive Behaviour Support

for children birth to 18 yrs. old

Support plans based on the Board Certified Behaviour Analyst's assessment to help your child or youth's skills and/or reduce challenging behaviours using positive behaviour supports.

Parent support sessions are also available.

Project Affinity

for children 8 to 18 yrs. Old *For youth with a diagnosis of ASD and other disabilities.*

Small peer groups that encourage positive peer learning and the exploration of social skills.

Youth must partake independently without 1-1 support.

Family Support Worker Program

Referrals are made by our staff

Families on our caseload may receive support from this program.

Our Free Services

Anybody can use these services

Family Navigator & Recreation

Coordinator ages 0 to 6 yrs. old

We connect families with community programs and services, serving Salmon Arm, Canoe and Silver Creek. Come and join us at our playgroups.

Child Care Resource & Referral

Provides child care referrals to parents, help with affordable child care benefits and child care provider training and business set up.

Book Program

Stop in anytime to pick up a book for your child or youth.
