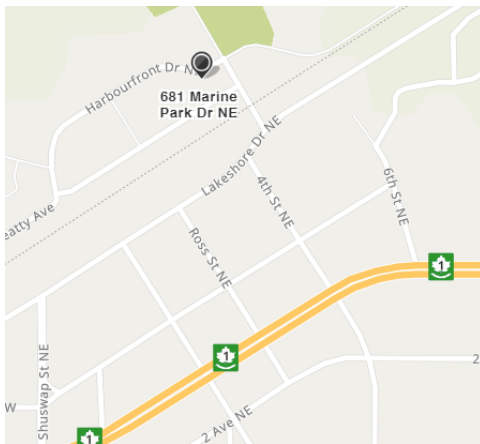

Our highly trained and compassionate team understands every child has different needs. We can provide navigation and support every step of the way.



Fees

Social Skills Groups: \$105 per session

- The fee is based on 4 hrs of BI time and 2 hrs of BCBA time
- Maximum of 4 children per group
- Groups run year-round and children can join at any time.

Professional Fees:

- Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) \$120/hr
- Behaviour Interventionist (BI) \$45/hr
- Physical or Occupational Therapist (PT or OT) \$120/hr

What We Do

We provide a number of services for families with children/youth aged 2 to 18 years of age.

Programs are designed to teach skills such as:

- communication
- self-advocacy
- tolerating disappointment
- transitioning between activities
- waiting
- following instructions
- group participation
- daily living skills, such as toileting and dressing

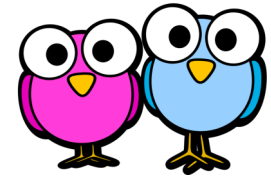
