## Our FREE programs:

For families with children/youth with a diagnosis, developmental delays, or support needs.  
Our staff visit families at our office, in their homes, in the community, and virtually.

Program	Age Range	Program Description
Infant Development	Focused on 0 to 3 years old. Exceptions for 3 to 6 years old.	Support for children at risk for, or with a developmental delay, or a diagnosis.
A Pathway to Hope	0 to school age.	Pathways available: Family support, early years mental health, Indigenous support, and behavioural support.
Physiotherapy	0 to school entry.	Improves development in movement, mobility, and muscular difficulties. Addresses plagiocephaly.
Occupational Therapy	0 to school entry.	Assists with teaching and supporting children and families with difficulties in daily living activities.
Supported Child Development	Focused on 0 to 6 years old. Special exceptions for 7-18 years old.	Consultation and support for eligible children needing extra support to attend inclusive childcare programs. Supports children, families, and childcare providers.
Keyworker; FASD & Complex Behaviour Support	For families with children 0 to 18 years old Community training and parent support groups are also available.	Support and information for complex developmental behaviours. Helps families, youth, and professionals. A diagnosis is not required.
Family Service Worker	For families with children 0 to 18 years old.	Provides families community resources and information. Assistance with paperwork before an assessment.
2SLGBTQI+ Program	For families and youth 8 to 18 years old.	Three services are available: 1 to 1 Support for youth 8 to 18 years old, Family Support, and a youth drop-in group for ages 13 to 18 years old.

## Our Fee for Service Programs: Children/youth do not need a diagnosis to attend.

Families can pay through autism funding, online learning funding, 3<sup>rd</sup> party funding, or private funds.

Program	Age Range	Program Description
Nest Behaviour and Autism Supports	Referrals can be made for children 2 to 5 years of age. Once accepted they can stay in the Nest until 18 years of age.	Communication, activities of daily living, tolerating, transitioning, and other skills based on individual needs.
FLY Youth Groups (ages are flexible, based on the best fit for your youth)	For youth 6 to 18 years of age with support needs. No diagnosis is required, all support needs are welcome. Youth must be able to join independently or with a private support worker.	Age-Based Peer Groups: Tailored groups for different age ranges to ensure age-appropriate support and interaction. Life & Social Skills Development: Focus on communication, emotional regulation, conflict resolution, and leadership. Social Activities: Games, creative arts, sports, and community outings to build friendships and confidence.
