Program	Age Range	Program Description
Infant Development	0 to school entry	Support for developmental delays or inquires, or a diagnosis
Physiotherapy	0 to school entry	Improves development in movement, mobility & muscular difficulties
Occupational Therapy	0 to school entry	Assists support needs or learning difficulties with daily living activities
Supported Child Development	0 to school entry	Support and consultation for children needing extra support to attend a child care program
FASD Keyworker	0 to 18 yrs old	Helps families, youth, and professionals understand FASD
Family Support Worker	For parents with children 0 to 18	Support for families facing difficult situations or a diagnosis
A Pathway to Hope	0 to school entry	Support for children with behaviours related to mental health concerns
2SLGBTQI+ Program	8 to 18 years old	Drop-In Group (13-18), 1-to 1 Support (8-18) and Family Support

Program	Age Range	Program Description
Nest; Positive Behaviour Support & Autism Services	2 to 5 years of age at the start of service their service. Over 5 years of age for those that started with us.	Communication, activities of daily living, tolerating, transitioning and other skills based on individual need
Project Affinity	8 to 13, able to participate without 1-1 support, no diagnosis required, all support needs welcome.	Small indoor after school peer group, fun themes, social and group skills.
FLY; Friends & Leisure Youth Recreation	8 to 18, able to participate without 1-1 support, no diagnosis required, all support needs welcome.	Youth groups. Recreation activities, life and social skills. Night and daytime youth groups, spring break and summer camps, Pro D days, overnight camps.

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
